Victoria Falls Safari Club is set high on a plateau just three kilometres from Victoria Falls town. The plateau forms a natural boundary to the unfenced Zambezi National Park, allowing for sweeping views of the surrounding landscape from the lodge, whose thatch and timber building spans seven levels. The property has the feel of a large safari lodge.

DAY 1: VICTORIA FALLS SAFARI CLUB, VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe

Resting on the southern banks of the Zambezi River at the western end of the eponymous falls, this popular touristtown is compact enough to walk around and makes an ideal base for travellers exploring the seventh wonder of theworld, the unfathomably vast Victoria Falls. About two-thirds of the falls can be viewed from the Zimbabwean sideand, while the falls are undoubtedly the star attraction, the area provides both adventure seekers and sightseers with plenty of opportunities to warrant a longer stay. Popular activities include scenic flights over the falls inhelicopters or microlights, bungee jumping off the Victoria Falls Bridge, white-water rafting (seasonal), and day tripsto Chobe National Park. The town itself offers some excellent accommodation and restaurant options as well as aneclectic variety of African curios and authentic art sold by friendly Zimbabwean locals who are wonderfullywelcoming and eager to help you enjoy your stay. This award-winning restaurant is open on three sides and overlooks the waterhole atVictoria Falls Safari Lodge, offering a unique opportunity to view elephant and other wildlife as you enjoy your meal–truly some of the finestdining in Victoria Falls. The a la carte dinner menu includes popular dishes with a local twist such as flame-grilled warthog, Zambezi bream, seared kudu fillet and crocodile stir-fry, while the lunch menu offers a selection of pies, salads and a sushi platter. Breakfast consists of an extensive continental buffet and an a la carte selection of cooked dishes, such as the 'Livukile' breakfast of soft poached eggs on toasted brown bread,





with honey glazed ham and grilled tomato toppedwith hollandaise sauce. MaKuwa-Kuwa Restaurant is open for breakfast from 7am to 10am, lunch from 12.30pm to 2pm and dinner from 7pm to 10pm. Bookings are essential for dinner. The dress code is smart-casual

The Boma–Dinner & Drum Show is a "must do" Victoria Falls dining and entertainment experience, specializing intraditional African food, drumming and dancing. The food is cooked and served in the style and quantity of a lavishfeast, including irresistible desserts. On arrival, you are dressed in a chitenge (traditional sarong) and welcomed into a vibrant atmosphere in which thetantalizing aromas of local dishes and game meat on the braai (barbecue) fill the restaurant,

which is partially opento the star-filled African sky. Your meal begins with a mouth-watering platter of starters whilst the buffet includes soup from the campfire, arange of salads, game meat cooked on a braai (barbecue), followed by desserts. Vegetarian options are alsoavailable, as well as local dishes such as peanut butter spinach. You can also look forward to outstanding performances by traditional singers and dancers, and enjoy an energizing interactive drumming show. A face painter, storyteller, hair braider and fortune teller also form part of this festive evening




