DAY 1-3: JOHANNESBURG/ SABI SAND

Your arrangements start at OR Tambo International Airport (formerly Johannesburg International), where our representative will assist you onto your charter flight to Simbambili Game Lodge, in the magnificent Sabi Sand Game Reserve.

This Lodge is an intimate and personal experience of Africa at its best. It is set among magnificent trees along the meandering Manyeleti River with views over extensive savannah grassland, home to abundant wildlife.



DAY 6: CAPE TOWN/ FRANSCHHOEK (CAPE WINELANDS)

This morning your hired car will be delivered to your hotel, and you can set out to the heart of the Cape's Winelands, the quaint and picturesque village of Franschhoek. Your accommodation is at Le Franschhoek Hotel and Spa – a new addition to Franschhoek, and already well known as a romantic getaway.

DAY 7-8: FRANSCHHOEK/ HERMANUS

You can take a leisurely, and very scenic drive to Hermanus this morning, where you will be staying at The Marine, a majestic, and beautifully situated five star Hotel – with incredible views of the Bay – famous for its seasonal whale watching. This is where the Southern Right whales come to breed between October and March every year. Hermanus is also known to have the best land-based whale watching anywhere.

The Marine has 43 individually decorated bedrooms and suites, each with its own private facilities, and air-conditioning. Commanding views extend across Walker Bay or over the beautiful internal courtyard, finely manicured gardens and the Overberg Mountains.

Stroll along the cliff hugging path and take in the breath-taking views of the Bay. The sparkling, heated courtyard pool might beckon, perfect for catching some African sun or sip a glass of local wine in The Sun Lounge with nothing between you and the South Pole, other than 3,000 miles of ocean.


